## **Existing 2020 Reservations**

Each tour operator will contact travelers directly via email of any status updates for a particular trip. In the event of a postponed or canceled trip, operators will provide you with options for the next steps. The decision about what to choose is a personal one. It is important to remember that WSU Alumni Travel is not responsible for trips postponed or canceled by our vendors; all traveler payments are processed by each vendor directly, and those specific trip and cancellation policies remain in place.

## **Extended Cancellation Windows**

## **Applying Travel Vouchers**

In most instances, our tour operators will offer a trip voucher to be redeemed at a later date.
